Then he went onto work for the ECPAD (The cinema organization for French Army) where he made a variety of films, for museums, for Ministry of Defense and for TV. During that time he also directed short films and documentaries, of which several Africa. In 2012, he filmed "Love Birds", a drama set in the near future. Then came the short films "Split time" and "Time 2 Split" which have now been officially selected in over 240 international festivals and have won several awards. These were followed by the comedy's shorts "Diagnosis" and "Dad in mum" selected by 100 and 260 international festivals respectively and the recipients of several audience awards. With these films, he won more than 110 awards around the world. All these short films have been bought by and shown on France Télévisions.

All this fairy tale ends suddenly, in a morning, when the house is silent. No music on the radio, no newspaper sound, silence in the kitchen. The house becomes too big, the space too empty. Mr Grosu has one last decision to take.

Raluca Racean Gorgos is a Romanian film director. She graduated the National University of Theatrical Arts and Cinematography in Bucharest. After Graduation she deepen her knowledge on film directing and producing by participating in Hollywood Film Institute Program, Transilvania Talent Lab and Aristoteles Workshop. During the Aristoteles Workshop, she made her documentary film The Bed is Broken, that was selected in numerous festivals like: IDFA Amsterdam, Jihlava International Film Festival in Check Republic, One World Romania, Kerala International Film Festival in India, Cronograf International Documentary Film Festival, Astra film festival and other. She received the AW Best film Award, and was nominated for Silver Eye Award at Jihlava Film Festival. With her newest film "4 1/2 senses" she won The Pitch by Shorts TV and had it?s premiere at Drama International Short Film Festival, Greece 2016.,

Expelled from the school of photography in Barcelona (the following year they exhibited pictures of me right there, as an example for the students) and without having entered any school of Cinematography, I decided to embark on this exciting journey in 1990. I have participated in many International Festivals, I had the honor of being given



a Section to my name at the International Film Festival of Catalonia (Sitges Film Festival) in 2003 where I was able to present all the short films I wanted. I was in the Forum of Cultures 2004 of Barcelona with other works. At the Berlinale too. In Buenos Aires making an exhibition of Photography and Video (Esteban Lisa Foundation, year 2005), and so on ... Then came the silence. After a tough fight against the disease of pancreatitis, in 2014 I embarked on a pioneering project in northern Argentina: The Film Workshop for Children and Teenagers (I came to this country because of the crisis, although I miss my hometown: Barcelona). In this project I try to teach Cinematography to the little ones, where pedagogy and art come together and project lots of moments of happiness, fun and ... very interesting short films! I wondered if we could enter the professional circuit of Short Film Festivals in 3 years and ... here we are! Being selected with several works of my students from 2017, and winning prizes in addition! This is paradise! Aleix Masferrer López at 17 years old with his mother watched the film "Todo sobre mi madre" ("everything about my mother") by Pedro Almódovar. He was stunned by this masterpiece. Then he knew he wanted to tell stories. When he finished his Bachelor studies he wanted to try with the world of the cinema in ESCAC (Superior School of Cinema of Catalonia). He decided with the support of his parents that he wanted to dedicate himself to the audio-visual world. He studied Audio-visuals at the ITES school in Barcelona, where he began to make his first audio-visual projects. But it was not until he started his master's degree in Film Directorate and Production at the UPC Polytechnic University of Catalonia, with the support of ECIB Barcelona Film School, which made his first short films: his first short film in HDV, Ya no te quiero" ("I do not love you anymore") with over 556,000 views on the youtube channel. Among his fellow students, he was chosen for the direction of the final master project for its "Despierta" (Wake Up) story. At just 25 years, Aleix Masferrer directed his short film Despierta (Wake Up") in 35 mm and starring the great actress Bibiana Schönhöfer. He was selected in international festivals like the Fantasporto of Portugal in 2009. That same year Masferrer began to work as Production Manager in the television channel Canal Català de Cataluña, where he began his television production career. At the same time, he also directed the three video clips of the Catalan rumba group Barrionegro from his third album. In 2011, he wrote and directed the most difficult story at the management level, Rosas Rotas ("Broken Roses") produced by himself. The main characters were three great actresses: Lorena Franco, friend and co-worker of Aleix, again Bibiana Schönhöfer and the wellknown actress nominated for a Goya, Macarena Gómez. This short film was selected by the Girona Festival Film in its 23rd edition and in a Film Festival dedicated to Women in Chile In 2012, he directed two short films for the production company Vuela Films, written by one of his actresses Lorena Franco. He also directed an advertising spot for the Freixenet contest starring his muse Lorena Franco and Noé Blancafort, where Aleix went to the 50's with a great Lorena in a playback of Sara Montiel with its "perhaps". In the year 2013 he continued his career as a television producer on 8tv, private chain of Catalonia, on the program of the well-known Catalan journalist Josep Cuní. He directed the official video clip of Pride Barcelona 2014 of his friend since childhood, Olaya with his theme "A new illusion" by José Ramirez better known as José Barbazul. This year he also wrote his fourth movie short script, The Other, love has two faces, but it was not until the end of January of 2017 that he filmed it, produced by himself. This is the most mature story of his career as a screenwriter and director, starring the great actress Nur Aiza, whom he defines as a rough diamond that knew how to capture all the feelings of the character from the first moment. The Other is currently beginning to wander through film festivals around the world. At the same time he started working as Production Coordinator in the Lavinia Group for a new 8tv program.
